# Safecoat Grout Sealer - FOR INTERIOR USE ONLY

#### PRODUCT NUMBER AND CONTAINER SIZE 31203 (quart)

#### USE ON:

Unsealed tile grout. For previously sealed grout, conduct several small test patches for absorption and compatibility. Grout Sealer is compatible with all standard sanded or unsanded grouts. It is not compatible with urethane grout or grouts fortified with polymer additives.

#### SURFACE PREPARATION:

Grout must be clean, dry, free from dirt, dust, efflorescence, oil or any foreign matter/contaminants. Remove all mildew before coating any surface. It should not be necessary to apply a release compound to tiles before sealing, but note application instructions carefully. Always clean the surface with a mild neutral pH cleaner that leaves no residue. If you are unsure of any surface, testing with small samples is necessary.

#### **APPLICATION:**

**Topical:** Allow 48-72 hours post grout installation before applying sealer. Apply 2-3 coats liberally in an even manner, using a sponge, small brush, or any other tool which can be used comfortably. Flood coating is acceptable, but avoid puddling being careful not to leave sealer on tile surfaces. Allow 2-4 hours between coats. Remove any sealer from tile surfaces promptly.

**Mixture:** Grout Sealer can be used as a substitute for the water recommended by the grout manufacturer. This eliminates a topical treatment of sealer.

IMPORTANT: Wipe off any sealer which has not penetrated into the grout within 5 minutes; do not allow sealer which has not soaked in to dry on the surface (simply wipe off with a slightly damp cloth or sponge). Always test a sample for suitability prior to full use. Note: these instructions are intended to be general only and not exhaustive. The applicator should determine what preparation and techniques are best suited to the specific surface.

#### **CLEAN-UP:**

Clean tools and equipment while they are still wet with a warm soapy water

solution. To safely remove Safecoat Grout-Sealer that has dried on the tile, we recommend using the Blissfully Clean Clay Cleaner from Green Building Supply - http://www.greenbuildingsupply.com/All-Products/Cleaners-Household/Green-Building-Supply-Blissfully-Clean

#### **DRYING/CURING TIME:**

24 hours in normal conditions. Normal conditions include a dry surface, access to fresh air flow, moderate humidity, and temperatures above  $65^{\circ}$  F.

#### LIMITATIONS:

Safecoat sealers are made without formaldehyde preservatives. Do not contaminate. Store in airtight containers. Do not use when indoor temperature is below 55 degrees F. Do not freeze. Thick application, high humidity or conditions other than normal will cause Safecoat to dry and cure more slowly.

#### **HEALTH PRECAUTIONS:**

As with all coatings and sealers, keep container tightly closed and out of the reach of children. Do not take internally. Keep from freezing. Always use adequate ventilation.

**Optimum environmental conditions:** 

Temperatures 65-80 degrees F Humidity 35-65% Good ventilation High humidity above 65% can slow dry times by a factor of 2 times. Cooler temperatures can also slow dry time.

Testing is absolutely required. Be sure to allow adequate dry time in between coats.

Good ventilation will help accelerate dry times and reduce emissions.
